- 1. Do you want chemical sample &/or demo at the walk-thru?**
Yes, please provide sample of product. No, they do not want demo. They do want to know type of machine will be used.
- 2. Are you planning to provide the sq. ft. estimates for the Blue and Yellow areas, or at a minimum, the sq. ft. per floor?**
You may take measurements during mandatory walk-thru.
- 3. What time is the janitorial cleaning crew working?**
Monday thru Thursday approximately from 9:00 p.m to 1:00 a.m. and Fridays approximately from 4:30 p.m. to 9:00 a.m.
- 4. Is there an existing contract for spray service? What is the contract length?**
The current spray service is not under contract. It was obtained as urgent in response to COVID19. It will end as soon as possible; upon the start of the RFP awarded contract.
- 5. Is this prevailing wage?**
No. It is not for the protection and preservation of publicly owned or leased property, but to provide additional safety to the staff and public.
- 6. Will the vendor awarded the business also be decontaminating the facility in the case of a confirmed COVID19 case?**
The vendor may be called on to perform the services outside of the scheduled visits. Proposal should include hourly quote and response time estimate for this.
- 7. What is the difference between the yellow and blue areas on the drawings?**
The Court is requesting two separate quotes for the yellow and blue areas. The yellow is the primary area to be sprayed. It is still tentative if the blue areas will also be included in the contract, depending on budgetary constraints.
- 8. Is the vendor allowed to use Court electricity for the service?**
Yes.
- 9. Is County approval needed?**
No, the Court is governed by the State and completely separate from the County.
- 10. What is the expected response time for emergency spraying?**
Please include in your proposal the amount of time it will take you to respond.
