**GENERAL ORDER RE: IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY MEASURES**

In response to the dynamic threat of COVID-19 and exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the March 18, 2020 Order (“Order”) of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council of California, issued in response to the March 18, 2020 request for an emergency order made by the Superior Court of Imperial County (“Court”), this Court **HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. In addition to all provisions found in General Order 2020-1 that was issued by this court on March 19, 2020, additional provisions are necessary to protect the health and safety of the public, which is the Court’s overriding interest in restricting courthouse entry.

2. From April 1, 2020 until April 17, 2020, inclusive, all Imperial County courthouses will only allow public access to those members of the public that have business in the courthouse as follows:

- a. Parties, lawyers, and witnesses subpoenaed to testify may enter on the day of a hearing scheduled in their case.
- b. Those people entering to file documents with the court for any case type may enter if the documents are completed and ready to be filed.
- c. No other persons will be permitted entry without good cause.

3. After April 17, 2020, the provisions of this order will be extended to any date in which this Court is granted an extension of power under Government Code section 68115 to address the COVID-19 situation.

**THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.**
