**GENERAL ORDER RE: IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY RELIEF
AUTHORIZED PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 68115 BY CHAIR
OF JUDICIAL COUNCIL**

Exercising the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the April 17, 2020 Order (“Order”) of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council of California, issued in response to the April 16, 2020 request to extend the emergency order made by the Superior Court of Imperial County (“Court”), this Court **HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The public health emergency is ongoing and the orders contained in General Order 2020-1 issued by this court on March 25, 2020, are hereby extended until at least May 17, 2020.

2. The Court’s emergency powers under Government Code section 68115, as laid out in General Order 2020-1, have been extended until May 17, 2020.


3. All provisions of General Order 2020-3 remain in place, as they are tied to the Statewide Emergency Order by Honorable Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chief Justice of California and Chair of the Judicial Council (“Statewide Order”) dated March 30, 2020, not to the emergency powers granted to the Court under a request for an emergency order. To the extent that the Statewide Order conflicts with any General Order issued by the Court, the provisions of the Statewide Order will control.

4. To the extent that any Emergency Rules adopted by the Judicial Council conflict with any General Order issued by the Court, the provisions of the Emergency Rules will control.

5. This General Order supersedes and replaces General Order 2020-5.

THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.
