GENERAL ORDER RE: IMPLEMENTATION OF EMERGENCY MEASURES


In response to the dynamic threat of COVID-19 and pursuant to the authority granted under Government Code section 68115 and the April 17, 2020 Order (“Order”) of Chief Justice Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chair of the Judicial Council of California and the Statewide Emergency Order by Honorable Tani G. Cantil-Sakauye, Chief Justice of California and Chair of the Judicial Council (“Statewide Order”) dated April 29, 2020, the Superior Court of Imperial County (“Court”) HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Pursuant to the Statewide Order, the time periods under Penal Code section 1382 for conducting a criminal trial that were previously extended by no more than 60 days are now extended an additional 30 days, resulting in a total extension of 90 days calculated from the last date on which the trial initially could have been conducted under Penal Code 1382.

2. This extension applies to matters for which the last date on which trial could have been conducted falls between March 16, 2020 and June 15, 2020, inclusive.

THIS ORDER IS EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.
